State tax credit. Arizona offers an individual tax credit of 25% of the cost of the installation of a solar energy system, capped at \$1,000. The credit can be claimed when filing state taxes for the year when the installation occurred. If your state tax liability is under the amount of the credit, you can roll over the credit into subsequent tax years, up to five years from your installation.
