



# Average cost of a 9kw solar system

How much does a 9 kW solar system cost?

This comes out to \$24,930 for a 9-kilowatt system before federal tax incentives, so the net cost of a 9-kW solar energy system would be \$18,448. This cost doesn't factor in any state or utility rebates and incentives for going solar. What are solar shoppers in your state paying for a 9 kW solar panel system?

How much does it cost to install a solar panel?

Solar panels generate "free" electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical 8-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system costs \$22,712 before considering any financial incentives. Your energy needs determine the system size you need, which affects the overall price of your solar panel installation.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210 before considering any financial incentives. However, a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

How much does a solar system cost?

Most people will need to spend between \$16,500 and \$21,000 for solar panels, with the national average solar installation costing about \$19,000. Most of the time, you'll see solar system costs listed as the cost per watt of solar installed so you can easily compare prices between quotes for different system sizes.

How much do solar panels cost per watt?

The average cost per watt for solar panels in the U.S. is \$2.84 for residential systems. High-efficiency monocrystalline panels tend to be at the higher end of the price range, but they generate more power with fewer panels--ideal if you have limited roof space.

How much does a 6 kW solar panel installation cost?

The average 6-kW residential solar panel installation is \$17,852 before incentives. Learn about cost factors, financing options, tax breaks and more.

Solar equipment costs. The panels themselves are probably the first thing that comes to mind when you think about going solar, but solar panels represent less than a third of the total solar equipment costs. You can expect all required solar equipment, including supply chain costs and sales tax, to cost \$13,800--about 46% of the total system ...

How much does a 12 kW solar system cost? While installation costs vary by region and installer, in 2016 the National Renewable Energy Lab found residential solar installations in the US cost an average of \$2.93 per watt before applying any financial incentives. At this rate then, a 12 kW system costs around \$35,160.

As of 2024, the average cost of a 9kW solar system in the United States ranges from \$19,000 to \$27,000 before incentives or rebates. This price includes equipment, installation, and other associated costs.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt - that comes out to about \$55,400 for a 20 kW system. That means the total cost for a 20 kW solar system would be \$40,996 after the federal solar tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt (\$11,080 for a 4 kW solar system). That means the total cost for a 4,000-watt solar system would be \$8,200 after the 26% federal tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).

Based on the average cost of solar in 2024, a 6 kW solar system in the U.S. will cost about \$18,000. With the 30% federal tax credit, the solar system price drops down to about \$12,000. Depending on where you live, you can benefit from additional state or utility-based solar rebates and incentives that may reduce the price even more.

To achieve a 9.2kW solar system, you would need 31 or more panels. Each panel typically has a size of 17 square feet, so the total footprint of a 9.2kW solar system would be around 521 square feet. How Big is a 9.2 kW Solar System? In terms of physical size, a 9.2kW solar system requires a significant amount of space.

The next thing you probably want to know is how much a 4kW installation will set you back. The National Renewable Energy Lab studied installation costs for residential solar in 2016 and found the average cost for residential solar to be around \$3 per watt. Using this amount, we estimate that a 4kW installation costs about \$12,000.
