How much do solar panels cost in Arizona?

As of September 2024, the average solar panel system costs \$2.15/W including installation in Arizona. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$10,747 before incentives, though prices range from \$9,135 to \$12,359. After the federal tax credit, the average price drops by 30%. While a 5 kW system will only cost you \$10,747 in Arizona, doubling the system size effectively doubles the price, so you'll pay about twice that for a 10 kW system.
