

What is an ocean-compressed air energy storage system?

Seymour [98, 99] introduced the concept of an OCAES system as a modified CAES system as an alternative to underground cavern. An ocean-compressed air energy storage system concept design was developed by Saniel et al. and was further analysed and optimized by Park et al. .

How efficient is adiabatic compressed air storage?

More than 70% efficiency (from literature) was also obtained when thermal energy storage was also integrated in adiabatic CAES systems. With the use of a radial compressor, an adiabatic compressed air storage system operating at a lower temperature was also investigated.

What are the limitations of adiabatic compressed air energy storage system?

The main limitation for this technology has to do with the start up, which is currently between 10 and 15 min because of the thermal stress being high.
