Do solar panels need cleaning?

How do you clean solar panels?

The best way to clean solar panels is to use a soft-bristled brush or squeegee specifically designed for solar panels, along with a mild soap or specialized cleaning solution. Avoid abrasive materials, excessive pressure, and cleaning during the hottest part of the day. Rinse thoroughly and dry the panels to prevent water spots.

How do you clean a solar inverter?

Shut off your solar panel system. This cuts the power flowing to the inverter and should always be the first step. Put on your rubber gloves and boots. Use a soft brush to remove debris like dirt, dust, or animal droppings. Mix dish soap with lukewarm water and gently wash the surface of the panels with your soft sponge or cloth.

Spray your panels with a garden hose, safely from the ground - do not get on your roof. Do not use harsh cleaning chemicals that could damage the panels. You should not clean your solar panels during the hottest part of the day because the extreme temperature difference between the water and the solar panels may cause the glass to crack.
