



Cleaning rooftop solar panels

How do you clean solar panels?

The best way to clean solar panels is to use a soft-bristled brush or squeegee specifically designed for solar panels, along with a mild soap or specialized cleaning solution. Avoid abrasive materials, excessive pressure, and cleaning during the hottest part of the day. Rinse thoroughly and dry the panels to prevent water spots.

Should you clean your solar panels?

Do a monthly visual inspection to look for any noticeable dust buildup. Also, you can watch your electric bill or check your solar system monitoring app for any noticeable drop in production. Only then should you worry about cleaning your solar panels. And even then, nature is most likely going to clean them for you.

How do you clean a solar inverter?

Shut off your solar panel system. This cuts the power flowing to the inverter and should always be the first step. Put on your rubber gloves and boots. Use a soft brush to remove debris like dirt, dust, or animal droppings. Mix dish soap with lukewarm water and gently wash the surface of the panels with your soft sponge or cloth.
