#### How long does a Sonicare toothbrush battery last?

Consider your usage. If you brush very frequently,or if many different people share the same Sonicare electric toothbrush, your battery life will be shorter than 3 weeks. It's possible that your battery is faulty. If you notice this within the 2 year warranty period, contact Philips for a free replacement.

### How long does a Philips Sonicare battery last?

Philips Sonicare electric toothbrushes with lithium batteries can hold their charge for up to 3 weeksafter a single charge. This assumes you use them on average to brush twice a day, for 2 minutes each. NiMH batteries, on the other hand, only last for 2 weeks on a single charge. A drawback to Sonicare lithium batteries is the slightly higher cost.

The tutorial is based on the HX6530 model but may be applicable to other HX6500 series models and similar, such as the EasyClean HX6510, HX6511, HX6530, HX6581 and HX6582.

Based on a two-minute brushing session twice per day, the battery will last at least two to three weeks with a full charge.
