What is Duke Energy's Solar Rebate program?

Duke Energy's \$62 million solar rebate program - which will help North Carolina customers with the upfront cost of installing solar panels on their property - was approved this month by the North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC).

Does Duke Energy offer incentives for solar?

Duke Energy does not offer solar incentives or rebate programs for its customers. However, Duke Energy customers can take advantage of the federal solar tax credit if they qualify. The federal tax credit equals 30% of installation costs and directly reduces what you owe in federal income taxes.

Does Duke Energy have a private solar system in North Carolina?

Currently, in North Carolina, Duke Energy has more than 6,000 customers who have private solar systems - with a total capacity of just over 50 megawatts. The program expects to increase North Carolina's private solar market by 200 percent over the next five years, providing an economic boost for the state's solar installation business as well.

Does a solar battery save Duke Energy?

A solar battery does not save money on Duke Energy bills, but it may be worthwhile if you are interested in having backup power. Energy storage systems can keep your lights on during a power outage, but they tend to cost upwards of \$10,000.

Are solar panels a good investment for Duke Energy customers?

Installing solar panels is a good investment for Duke Energy customers because of net metering. For Duke Energy customers, net metering is a billing arrangement that allows solar system owners to get credit for all the energy their panels generate. This credit can be used to offset the cost of the energy they buy from the grid at night or when the sun isn't shining.

In March 2023, the North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC) approved a proposal that will revise Duke Energy's current net metering policy. The proposal was initially made in 2021, brought on by laws requiring utilities to reevaluate their net metering policies, and features modifications to how solar customers are billed.

With this program, if you pair your solar panel system with a battery, you could earn a one-time rebate worth up to \$9,000, including up to \$3,600 for the solar panels and \$5,400 for the battery.

Home Energy Check (HEC) In order to qualify for any of Duke Energy's Home Energy Improvement (HEI) rebates (Attic Insulation, Duct Test & Repair, HVAC or Energy-Efficient Windows), you must first complete a free Home Energy Check (HEC). The Home Energy Check must be completed before any work begins or have occurred within the past 24 months.

The state is a national leader for solar power - trailing only California and Texas in the amount of solar power produced. Overall, Duke Energy has more than 3,700 MW of solar energy connected to its energy grid in the state. The outlook for future solar power in North Carolina looks promising.

Utility-scale and residential solar installations are becoming more common. More than 18,000 Duke Energy customers in North Carolina have a private solar system - with a record-breaking 5,500 installed in 2020 alone. Duke Energy's five-year, \$62 million solar rebate program helped drive the growth by reducing start-up costs at homes and businesses.

Submit an Interconnection Request Work with your Trade Ally to complete the Interconnection Request and select a preferred rider that will allow you to connect your system to the grid.

The company's \$62 million solar rebate program has been very popular for customers looking to install rooftop solar. Application windows open in January and July of 2021. But the rebates go fast.
