Does Empress echosystem have a dual engine?

For double the trouble, the Empress Echosystem also features a powerful Dual Engine that lets you stack any two delays together in parallel, series, or left/right stereo. The result is limitless but immaculately rendered delay options for modern players.

Is the Empress echosystem worth it?

Given what the Empress Echosystem can do, the asking price is pretty reasonable. It's always hard to pull the trigger on a pedal that eclipses \$400, but if you're prioritizing delay in your rig than the Echosystem will be worth it. Keep in mind, it's definitely a tinkering pedal and not a set and forget type of thing.

Is the Empress echosystem a good pedal shark?

The Empress Echosystem's controls excel in their own right, but what's really impressed Sweetwater pedal sharks is its many external control options.

How many presets does the Empress echosystem delay store?

The Empress Echosystem delay stores up to 35 presets that are easy to access using an intuitive navigation system. Scroll through groups of five presets using the center scroll footswitch; LED lights change colors once you reach a new set of five, so it's easy to know where you're at in your bank.

What is the Empress echosystem delay interface?

The Empress Echosystem Delay interface is clean and efficient with a treasure trove of options beneath the hood. The 12 surface-level algorithms you see on the control panel packs a core palette of classic and experimental delays, and many of these contain alternate voicings for a grand total of 42 algorithms onboard.

How do I connect the Empress MIDIbox?

Connect the Empress Midibox (not included with the Echosystem) using a 1/4" patch cable to the control port. A TRS cable is required to send MIDI out messages if you're using the Echosystem to control other pedals. Configure the pedal for MIDI control and set the MIDI channel. See Advanced Configuration for instructions.

You have a ton of control over it. The Echo System has a bunch of algorithms that you can combine in multiple ways and that's where it gets its depth from. If I were to buy a \$400 delay, the Volante and Echo System would be on the top of the list. But I think the Echo System would win for me for the fact that you can get a simple delay easier.

I can, given time, dial in something truly original and then I'm able to save it as a patch for instant recall. I have old solid state echo devices as well and always liked the lo-fi sounds on straightforward guitar parts.

This is an important point about the Empress Echo System because there are 2 different delay engines running at once, both in stereo and you can run them in series, in parallel or mono left and mono right depending on your setup for crazy, otherworldly delay sounds.

SD Requirements to Update the pedal firmware you need: 1 - SD Card has to be SDHC type (the HC stands for high capacity, and almost every SD card made in the last 10 years is the HC type). 2 - The SD Card has to be formatted to FAT32.
