

Which energy storage technologies are included in the 2020 cost and performance assessment?

The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment provided installed costs for six energy storage technologies: lithium-ion (Li-ion) batteries, lead-acid batteries, vanadium redox flow batteries, pumped storage hydro, compressed-air energy storage, and hydrogen energy storage.

What is the 2020 grid energy storage technologies cost and performance assessment?

Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's 2020 Grid Energy Storage Technologies Cost and Performance Assessment provides a range of cost estimates for technologies in 2020 and 2030 as well as a framework to help break down different cost categories of energy storage systems.

Why is it important to compare energy storage technologies?

As demand for energy storage continues to grow and evolve, it is critical to compare the costs and performance of different energy storage technologies on an equitable basis.

Are recycling and decommissioning included in the cost and performance assessment?

Recycling and decommissioning are included as additional costsfor Li-ion,redox flow,and lead-acid technologies. The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment analyzed energy storage systems from 2 to 10 hours. The 2022 Cost and Performance Assessment analyzes storage system at additional 24- and 100-hour durations.

How many MW is a battery energy storage system?

For battery energy storage systems (BESS), the analysis was done for systems with rated power of 1,10, and 100 megawatts(MW), with duration of 2,4,6,8, and 10 hours. For PSH,100 and 1,000 MW systems at 4- and 10-hour durations were considered. For CAES, in addition to these power and duration levels, 10,000 MW was also considered.

How are cost and performance data compiled?

The cost and performance data were compiled for the defined categories and components based on conversations with vendors and stakeholders, literature, and costs of systems procured at sites across the US. Detailed cost, cost ranges, and performance estimates are presented for 2020 and projected out to 2030 for each of the technologies described.
