How do I make a solo FC?

Thank you. As you can't friend your own alts, you can't mail or /invite FC to them. The only way to make a solo FC is to either get some new or non-FC member players to except invites or to make a second account, populate it with alts, and then use them as the FC invitees.

What can you do in Final Fantasy 14?
