



Free solar panels for low income families

The 60 selections under the \$7 billion Solar for All program will provide funds to states, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and nonprofits across the country to develop long-lasting solar programs that enable low-income and disadvantaged communities

Connecting LIHEAP-eligible households with community solar subscriptions will lower energy bills for families, increase access to clean energy among underserved communities, and increase equitable solar energy deployment, in support of President Biden's ambitious clean energy and Justice40 goals.

There are a number of state, non-profit, and utility-level low-income solar programs to help qualifying homeowners get home solar panels. Although there are no federally-run low-income solar programs, the Biden-Harris Administration announced \$7 billion in Solar

We provide low-to-no cost solar electric systems to families that qualify as low income, and install them using a barnraising model that gives volunteers and job trainees hands-on experience they can use to get jobs in the growing solar industry.

Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.

The Solar for All competition, which was created by the Inflation Reduction Act's Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund, will award up to 60 grants to states, territories, Tribal governments ...

LIHEAP is an HHS program that assists eligible low-income households with home energy costs. Expanding community solar to all LIHEAP recipients could lead to gigawatts of new community solar deployment, increased access for low-income ...

Residential solar cuts home energy bills and provides families with resilient and secure power, and Solar for All will help low-income and disadvantaged communities experience these meaningful benefits, such as guaranteeing a minimum 20% total electricity bill
