



# Hard power systems

What is hard power?

In short, hard power is defined as the capacity to get what you want through the coercive use of economic power and the application of military force. To borrow from Carl von Clausewitz's adage, "War is the continuation of politics by other means."

What is the difference between hard power and soft power?

Hard power refers to the power a nation has to coerce other nations through military and economic means. It is a 'carrot and stick' approach (Nye, 2009). Soft power, on the other hand, refers to the power nations have to convince, attract, and influence other nations through means such as diplomacy and cultural exchange (Nye, 1991; Qin, 2018).
