Prepare a level stone or concrete base for the generator. Set the generator on the base. Dig a trench from the generator to your new high-pressure gas meter. Connect the gas line to the meter. Pull the electrical cable from the generator to your house through a conduit. Connect gas and electricity to the rear of the generator.

#### Where should a generator be installed?

However, it must also be at least 5 feet away from windows, doors, and even soffit vents. Also, generators need a stable base. In many cases, the best option is to install the generator on a concrete slab specifically for the generator.
