

How to flush power steering system chevy silverado

While changing your Chevy Silverado"s power steering fluid, detaching and reattaching power steering hoses can be somewhat daunting. Fluid levels should be maintained at all times, and under normal circumstances a power steering pump should be bled every 50,000 miles.

Bleeding the power steering system. The usual suspect in power steering fluid leaks is the power steering pressure hose. In the process of fixing where the air gets in, it's easy to introduce some more. After replacing a power steering pump or pressure hose, it's always a good plan to flush and bleed the power steering system of air.
