

How do I back up my iPhone?

iCloud automatically backs up your iPhone daily when iPhone is connected to power,locked,and connected to Wi-Fi. Note: On models that support 5G,your carrier may give you the option to back up iPhone using your cellular network. Go to Settings > [your name]> iCloud > iCloud Backup,then turn Back Up Over Cellular on or off.

How do I backup my iPhone & iPad?

After you back up your iPhone or iPad, you have a copy of your information to use in case your device is ever replaced, lost, or damaged. You can back up your device manually, or turn on iCloud Backup to automatically keep your device backed up. Connect your device to a Wi-Fi network. Go to Settings > [your name], and tap iCloud. Tap iCloud Backup.

How often should I backup my iPhone to iCloud?

You have the choice of backing up your iPhone to iCloud, your Mac, or iTunes on a PC. And the method you pick will determine the frequency of your iPhone backup. If you use Apple's iCloud backup, your phone will automatically back up every time your phone is locked, connected to power, and connected to a Wi-Fi network.

How to use iCloud backup on iPhone?

Tap iCloud Backup and slide the iCloud Backup slider to on. 1. Connect your iPhone to your Mac using a Lightning-to-USB or Lightning-to-Thunderbolt cable, depending on the available ports on your Mac. 2. If you're asked to trust your computer on your iPhone, enter your passcode. 3.

How to backup iPhone to Mac?

At the top of the Finder window, click General. Select "Back up all of the data on your iPhone to this Mac." To encrypt your backup data and protect it with a password, select "Encrypt local backup." Click Back Up Now. Note: You can also connect iPhone to your computer wirelessly if you set up syncing over Wi-Fi.

How do I backup my iPhone to my computer?

To perform a manual backup, tap Back Up Now. To view details about iCloud backups, such as last backup, backup size, and the apps included in the backup, go to Settings > [your name] > iCloud > iCloud Backups, then tap a device. You can turn off apps you don't want to back up to iCloud anymore; this will also delete the app's existing backup data from iCloud.

When on the home screen, click the Retrieve iTunes Backup Password card. The tool shall show a tabular list of all existing iOS device backup files. If you don't see the backup you're looking for, click the import backup files in the hyperlink below the table. You must select a backup either from the table or by importing manually.

The syncing indicator (spinning arrows next to the wireless or cellular indicator) will stay on during the whole backup. The initial one will take some time, especially if you have a lot of data on your iPhone, but subsequent ones will be faster. The backup is stored in /home/pi/iphone in a subdirectory identified by the iPhone serial number.

For Windows users as far as I know this is still a feature in iTunes. But I just pay Apple iCloud to backup my phone now. I'm not 100% certain if the automatic backup feature is still available. It used to be if you plugged your iPhone into a power source, it would auto-backup to iTunes via WiFi so long as iTunes was running.
