

Will HDRE build a new energy storage system in Japan?

Jason Chou, General Manager of HDRE, outlined the company's ambitious plan to build 1.5GW of energy storage systems in Japan over the next three years, involving a capital investment of approximately NT\$50 billion.

Why are battery storage projects growing in Japan?

The ramp up of battery storage projects in Japan continues apace, aided by growing subsidy avenues and rising volumes on various electricity markets, from spot to balancing to capacity.

How big is Japan's energy storage capacity?

Global energy storage capacity was estimated to have reached 36,735MW by the end of 2022 and is forecasted to grow to 353,880MW by 2030. Japan had 1,671MW of capacity in 2022 and this is expected to rise to 10,074MW by 2030. Battery storage is urgently needed for the renewable energy transition, and is expected to play a huge role in Japan's future power system. Businesses see battery storage as a complement to their renewable energy strategy, and a strong opportunity to improve their bottom line while accelerating their path to decarbonization.

Japan, which targets renewable energy representing 36% to 38% of the electricity mix by 2030 and 50% by 2050, is seeking to promote energy storage technologies as an enabler of that goal. At the same time, electricity demand forecasts for the coming years have risen due to the expected increased adoption of AI and the growth of data centres.

Indeed, the government's three-year Basic Energy Plan aims for renewables to reach 22-24% of the national energy mix by that year. That would peg solar's share at around 64GW. But, as Kaizuka says, nuclear energy isn't generating anymore in Japan since the Fukushima Daiichi reactor was damaged by the 2011 earthquake and tsunami.

Japan is targeting net zero emissions from its economy by 2050, with an interim target of getting to between 36% and 38% renewable energy on the grid by 2030. To get to that target, the Japanese government has recently re-prioritised its focus on decarbonisation of the power sector to include energy storage as well as renewable energy generation.

The network company has already determined that new wind and solar plants must be equipped with equipment to control their grid output, with a recently completed solar farm in the region among the first in Japan to be combined with large-scale battery storage.
