While Missouri does not offer any tax breaks, it does have several solar rebate incentives. You can also apply for a low-interest solar loan if you cannot pay for your system out-of-pocket. Several local power companies in Missouri offer solar rebate programs for their customers.

Is solar energy a good investment in Missouri?

Everygy's Missouri utilities offer a 25 cent per watt rebate for solar installations. To qualify, the system must be less than 25 kW. Missouri residents can also use the Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) program to get a loan to purchase solar equipment.
