

How does a pumped storage hydropower project work?

Pumped storage hydropower projects use electricity to store potential energy by moving water between an upper and lower reservoir. Using electricity from the grid to pump water from a lower elevation, PSH creates potential energy in the form of water stored at an upper elevation, which is why it is often referred to as a "water battery".

Even though PSH is the most cost-effective form of grid energy storage currently available, new pumped storage development faces several challenges, such as its licensing and the valuation of the services it can provide. Accordingly, there has been very little new pumped storage development in the United States over the past 30 years.

A pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) site requires two water bodies at different altitudes. The larger the difference in altitude, or head, the better, as the cost per unit of energy and power falls with increased head. Heads greater than 500m are preferred. On sunny and windy days water is pumped uphill to the upper reservoir.

The pumped hydro storage capacity resource per million people for the UN geo sub-regions is shown in Figure 4.
