\$20,125 after the 30% tax credit.  $2,500 \times \$11.50 = \$28,750$ . While this method provides a quick-and-dirty estimate for the cost of solar panels, solar systems are sized based on electricity consumption -- not the size of your home.

With average project costs of around \$24,000 to \$29,000, SunPower's panels can be a bit more expensive than many competitors' products. But you certainly get significant value for your money.
