How to remove a battery from a Sony toothbrush?

Pull out the internals of the toothbrush. Open the protective cover of the battery. Check the battery model. In this case, the model is a Sony 680mAh lithium battery. Open the protection cover of the circuit board. Find the welding points of the positive and negative electrodes of the battery and use the soldering iron to desolder.

How do you replace a Philips toothbrush battery?

Replace the two screws at the base of the toothbrush handle using the Philips screwdriver. Reattach the brush head by twisting it clockwise until it clicks into place. Place the toothbrush on the charging base to charge the new battery and ensure proper functionality.

Pull upwards to remove the brush head from the top of the device. Remove the 12 mm T8 Torx screw from the bottom of the toothbrush.
