Can you recycle batteries at Staples?

Recycle your rechargeable batteries in store. *Limit of seven items can be recycled per customer per day. Store management has the right to refuse to accept items that may pose a health or safety risk. What is free tech recycling? Staples accepts a wide range of electronic items for free recycling every day.

Where can I drop off rechargeable batteries?

Drop off rechargeable (non-lead acid) stand-alone batteries (from cell phones, laptop computers, and power tools etc.) at Battery Bill's. Home Depot accepts rechargeable batteries from power tools.

It is important to note that the chasing arrow symbol (i.e., three arrows forming a triangle) on Li-ion batteries means you can recycle these batteries at specialized battery recyclers; it does NOT mean you can put Li-ion

Lithium ion batteries that are rechargeable are typically found in digital cameras, cell phones, laptop computers, and e-cigarettes. Yes, lithium batteries can be recycled under the definition of solid waste recycling exclusion at 40 CFR 261.4(a)(24) and/or 40 CFR 261.4(a)(25) (for recycling occurring domestically and after export, respectively) as long as (1) both the state that the batteries are generated in and the state in which the recycling takes place have adopted ...
