How to fix power icon grayed out Windows 10?

Click the Action tab at the top of the window and select Scan for hardware changes. Verify the Microsoft AC Adapter and Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery devices are displayed. Once all steps are finished, check whether the issue of power icon grayed out is fixed. Way 2. Disable and Enable Microsoft Drivers

Why is my battery icon grayed out Windows 10?

If the battery icon is still grayed out, proceed to the next section. Open the Windows Device Manager. Expand the Batteries section. Right-click the Microsoft AC Adapter and Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery devices and select the Disable option. Right-click the two devices again and select Enable.

Why is my notification icon grayed out on Windows 10?

If you can see the icon, but it is grayed out, try the following steps to resolve the problem. 1-Right-click on the clock by the notification area on the taskbar and select Customize Notification Icons. 2-In the Notification Area Icons window, check the Power option and make sure it is set to Show icon and notifications.

Why is my laptop icon greyed out?

The cause for a greyed out icon or option can be due to multiple reasons. Below are troubleshooting ideas and steps for resolving the most common causes for the problem. Does Windows 10 have a power icon?

If the Power option here is grayed out, Windows 10 thinks you're using a desktop PC without a battery. The taskbar's power icon won't appear on PCs without a battery. Even after you've restored the battery icon, it won't show an estimate of the remaining battery time when you mouse over it.

How do I Fix my Windows 10 battery icon?

Expand the Batteries section. Right-click the Microsoft AC Adapter and Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery devices and select the Disable option. Right-click the two devices again and select Enable. Restart the laptop and see if the battery icon is now visible and no longer grayed out in the notification area on the taskbar.

Try the following steps to try to bring the icons back to working as they should. Hold down the Windows Key and press the "R" key to bring up the Run window. Type "regedit", then select "OK".

Click on "Turn system icons on or off" so we can check if the icon is indeed turned on. Make sure that the "Power" option is checked. Now we will check if it is enabled to show in the taskbar. Go back and select "Select which icons appear on the taskbar". Make sure that the Power option is enabled. After making the necessary changes ...

1. Left click on windows icon and choose settings. 2. Click on display tab. 3. Change the size of text to 125% Then apply. 4. DO NOT LOG OUT YET. Choose sign out later! 5. Change the text size back to 100% and click apply. 6. Now sign out ...

Also, I've tried going into the settings menu to try and turn on notification icons, and I am unable to turn on the volume, clock, etc. icons. The only icons that currently show up are the "Task View" button, the notifications bubble, the "Touch Keyboard", and the calendar icon.

System File Checker is a utility in Windows that allows users to scan for corruptions in Windows system files and restore corrupted files. If a Windows Resource Protection (WRP) file is missing or is corrupted, Windows

may not behave as expected. Perform SFC(System file Checker) scan and see if it helps. a: Press Windows key + X.

1. Windows Key+i > Personalization > Taskbar > Turn system icons on or off > Toggle Power to On
2. Troubleshoot Power Type troubleshoot in Cortana Search > Click Troubleshoot > Scroll down > Click Power > Run the troubleshooter > Follow on-screen direction.

I've followed steps suggested for other windows versions with no luck. In taskbar properties, the blue box that should contain an icon, is empty. Note: the Windows Explorer (safely remove hardware and eject media) is also missing from taskbar and icon box is empty. In settings, the option to turn volume icon back on is greyed out.

Alternatively, you can click upward arrow button in taskbar notification area, click Customize then select Turn system icons on or off. Here you can turn on the options ...
